VOLUNTEER DESPATCHER - ROLE DESCRIPTION

INTRODUCTION

HcL is a major Scottish Charity based in the Lothians. The organisation was set up in

November 1982 to operate a transport service for people with a range of disabilities and

health needs who are unable, or have great difficulty, in using public transport.

HcL receives most of its funding from The City of Edinburgh Council, Midlothian Council,

East Lothian Council, West Lothian Council, Scottish Government and St. John to provide:

Dial-A-Ride: a door-through-door transport service

Dial-A-Bus: a semi-scheduled door-through-door shopping service

Our services cover Edinburgh and the Lothians, operating from our two local bases. We also

respond to requests for journeys nationally on an availability basis.

Currently there are twenty minibuses (Dial-A-Ride) and nine midibuses (Dial-A-Bus) in the

fleet which have been specially adapted to carry wheelchair users and ambulant

passengers.
